
January – March 2022

Aotea College has signed up to be SFEI member school after the meeting.


Nabilah Faridz (WNZ) and Jennifer Zhou (Wellington Council) also joined in the meeting.

Virginia and Roz were introducing Wellington Region to the parents.


A pilot parent meeting was scheduled on April 4 Monday with the intention to recruit potential students for Cohort 4.

Feedback we received was that the parents prefer Chinese-speaking staff to present their schools during the online session.

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A book to introduce Silver Fern Excellence Initiative and Wellington secondary schools was finalized at the end of 2021. The introduction of NCEA and Pastoral Care in New Zealand were also included. Parents will have a deeper understanding of the advantages of NZ education once they finish this book (200 pages, front and back). A new version will be issued, including new SFEI schools (Aotea College).

SFEI Plus mainly facilitates the collaborations between tertiary education providers from NZ and China, including Dual Bachelor Degree Program and Degree Transfer Program.

Schengen International Group (SIG) has signed up Agent Agreement with WelTec, thanks to WNZ and EWT's help. We are looking forward to signing up with more Universities and Polytechnics in the future.

SIG also helped Beijing City University and Unitec signed up the Degree Transfer Program in Architecture. We are working with another University to sign up with Weltec in the field of Music and Performing Arts.
